Some people just come for the challenge offered by our two fully equipped and challenging 18-hole golf courses. And if tennis is your game, we have several courts available.

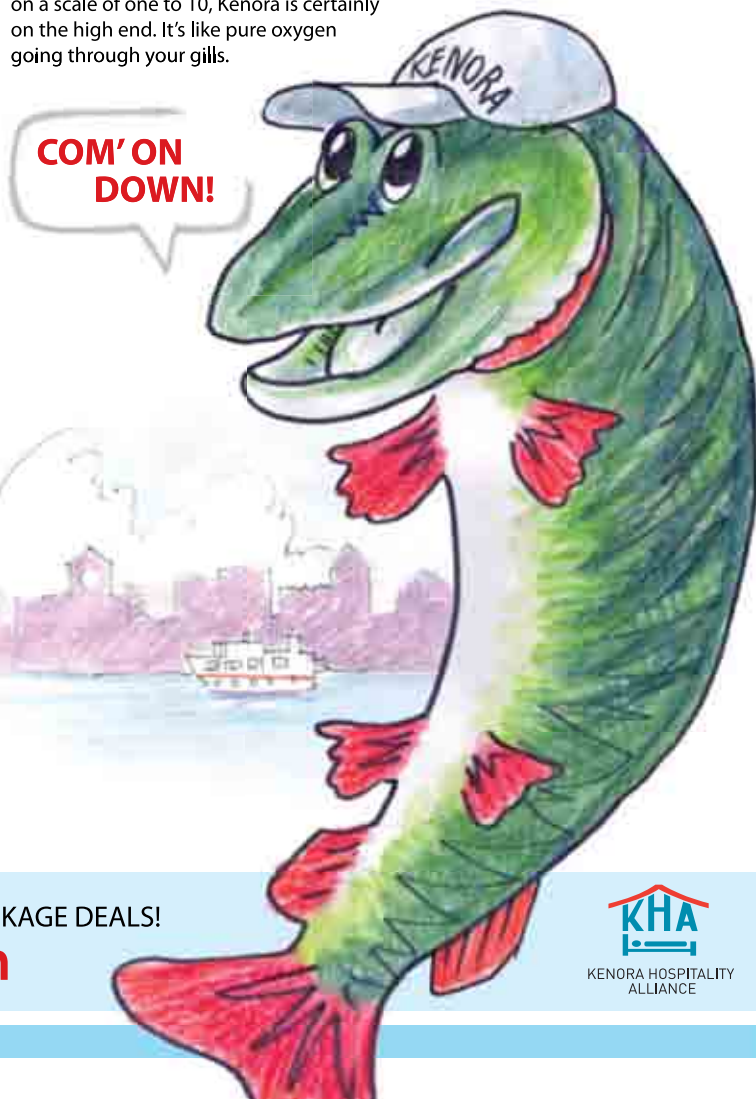
Sorry cousins but I have to mention fishing. Boat rentals are available but I suggest you arrange a guided trip to ensure success. Please, please practice catch and release.
